What is the Spark! Challenge?

The Northwell Health Spark! Challenge is an exciting competition that will enable teams of students from local high schools to participate in onsite “Career Days.” These Career Days will be hosted at multiple Northwell Health sites to introduce students to a variety of careers within health care. Your team will be hosted by dedicated Northwell Health staff who will introduce you and your classmates to various clinical and non-clinical careers at their facility. After your Career Day visit, you will be required to collaborate with your team members to create a career advertisement and a three minute career presentation (see Student Group Projects for more information). Prizes will be awarded to the most creative presentations and impactful advertisements, as determined by a team of judges.

1. Review the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) guidelines below.

It is very important that you are familiar with, and understand the importance of this information.

**Please note that the use of photos/videos containing patients/visitors, and/or any protected health information are prohibited.*

What is HIPAA?

In health care we are governed by rules and regulations in order to protect patient's private health records/information. HIPAA, which stands for the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, establishes standards that ALL health care providers must comply with. These rules apply to when, how and what kind of patient information can be shared.

It is **everyone's responsibility** to take confidentiality of patient information seriously.

- HIPAA covers **ALL** forms of protected health information: verbal, written, and electronic
- HIPAA gives patients control over the use of their health information and how it's shared

What is protected health information (PHI)?

Any health information that identifies someone or can be used to identify someone **MUST BE PROTECTED**. According to HIPAA all of the following information can be used to identify a patient:

- Addresses
- Dates
- Telephone or fax numbers
- Social Security Numbers
- Medical Record Numbers
- Insurance Plan Numbers
- Vehicle Information
- License Numbers
- Medical Equipment Numbers
- Photographs/videos
- Fingerprints
- Email addresses
- Internet addresses

Before visit:

- Submit your signed photo release form. **If you are under 18 years of age, the form must be signed by a parent or guardian.**
- Submit your completed medical clearance form (if you are attending a clinical setting).
- Visit Northwell.edu to learn about our organization and your designated site.
- Ensure pre-assignments have been completed: Review HIPAA Awareness and watch video.
- If you have any special dietary needs/restrictions, make sure to bring your lunch on the day of the trip.
- Communicate with your teacher/advisor about dress code: you might need sneakers if you are in a clinical environment or dress to impress if you are in a business setting, know before you go!

During visit:

- Get social! Follow our tips below and examples to make posts of your own.
- Use the hashtag: #NorthwellLife.

After visit:

- Meet with your group to create an advertisement of one career you learned during your Spark! Challenge visit.
- Share advertisement draft with your Northwell host team for feedback.
- Meet with your group to create a presentation for the Spark! Challenge Awards Celebration (see Student Group Packet).

Instagram tips

- Every photo post should have accompanying text; text can be as short as a single word or hashtag.
- Ideally choose one to three hashtags.
